PURPOSE

The Servant Leadership Scholarship Program honors students who consistently demonstrate a servant's heart combined with the ability to lead others in a service-oriented manner. Volunteer activities in a church, Para-church, social or civic organization will qualify for scholarship consideration. A limited number of scholarships will be awarded to deserving students by committee decision. Your application will be rated on a ten point scale by the committee members based on biblical content, demonstration of service, demonstration of leadership, maturity of character, and the persuasion of the reference letter.

QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for the Servant Leadership Scholarship Program, the student must be an accepted applicant to Clearwater Christian College, a resident student, have a minimum score of 1030 combined verbal and math on the SAT or an ACT score of 22, and have a completed FAFSA on file in the Financial Aid Office.

To apply:

1. Complete the attached application, providing **typed responses** to essay questions. **HANDWRITTEN RESPONSES WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
2. Provide one recommendation (use Servant Leadership Recommendation Form) from someone who can provide a reference regarding your leadership qualities. This individual may not be a family member.

All documentation including completed application, typed essay responses, and completed recommendation form should be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by **March 1, 2012.**
