Baseball Takes 3rd Straight With Win over Pasco



(3/2/10) Clearwater, FL- The Cougars hosted Pasco Hernando on Tuesday in what looked to be a very tough game for Clearwater. Mark Rawsthorne started the game for CCC and pitched well against a high powered Pasco Hernando offense. Albert Ulloa also had a great relief outing and kept the Cougars in the game. Heading into the bottom of the 9th inning, Clearwater trailed 6-5. However, Clearwater would not go down without a fight. With Ethan Barba on third and Joe Keen on second Luke Harding stepped to the plate. Harding lined a single up the

middle and the Cougars scored the game winning run in walk off fashion. Albert Ulloa was given the win and the Cougars have now won their third game in a row.

(3/4/10) Clearwater, FL- Clearwater Christian

College hosted Point Park University from Pittsburgh, PA on Thursday evening at Northside. The Cougars looked to continue their hot streak, and improve their win streak to 4. Cougar Ace Brent Kirkley took the mound and looked to lead CCC to another win and improve on his previous start after only allowing four runs on one hit to go along with fourteen strikeouts against Cedarville. With the game tied at 1-1 and Kirkley pitching another strong game, Cougar center fielder Ethan Barba hit a two run home run to put Clearwater up 3-1.

Point Park bounced back in the top of the 6th inning with a three run home run to take a 4-3 lead. Point Park went on to win the game by a final score of 4-3.

Kirkley took the loss giving up 4 runs, while striking out 6, in 5 innings of work.

(3/6/10) Clearwater, FL- The Cougars hosted Cedarville University on Saturday. Clearwater had previously swept a double header against Cedarville for their first two wins of the year. Junior Captain Josh Rebandt took the mound in this matchup as the Cougars looked to make it 3 in a row against the Yellow Jackets. Rebandt had trouble finding the strike zone early and the Cedarville offense jumped all over the Cougars to take a big lead in the early innings. Clearwater tried to fight back but the early deficit was too much as the Cougars dropped the game by a final score of 15-4.
