



MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This music scholarship application form is for use by both first-time and renewal applicants.

FIRST-TIME APPLICANTS

All applicants must submit a complete Music Scholarship application and audition. The Admissions Office will receive completed applications and schedule auditions. The priority date for receiving applications and completing auditions for each new academic year is **March 1**. Applications may be submitted and auditions scheduled after this deadline, however, scholarship awards will be based on available funds. Scholarships are awarded for piano, voice, and orchestral instruments only.

Audition Requirements: Students should prepare two classical selections of contrasting style. Memorization is not required for instrumentalists, but is preferred for pianists and vocalists. An accompanist will be provided if desired. Sight reading is required for all music scholarship candidates. A live audition on campus is preferred; however, if you cannot audition in person, we do accept DVDs, or digital files under 8MB in size. These should be mailed directly to Dr. Pattye Casarow, Music Department Chair, in care of the College or sent via email to pattyecasarow@clearwater.edu. Once applications are processed and auditions have been completed, the Music Department will forward its recommendation to the Financial Aid Office who will then act upon this request. Scholarship awards are based primarily on department performance needs in vocal and instrumental ensembles, as well as in accompanying. Students receiving scholarship funds may also qualify for other assistance. If a scholarship is awarded, it is understood that the student will participate in two ensembles (Concert Choir, Cantorum, Brass Ensemble, String Ensemble, Orchestra, and Bell Choir) or five hours of assigned accompanying, as determined by the music faculty.

RENEWAL APPLICANTS

Current students receiving a music scholarship must reapply for each new academic year. Auditions are not required. Renewal applicants must complete only page 1 of this application and submit it to Dr. Casarow. The priority deadline for receiving these applications for each new academic year is **March 1**. The Music department will evaluate the applicant's continued eligibility for the scholarship based on award criteria and submit their recommendation to the Financial Aid Office.
