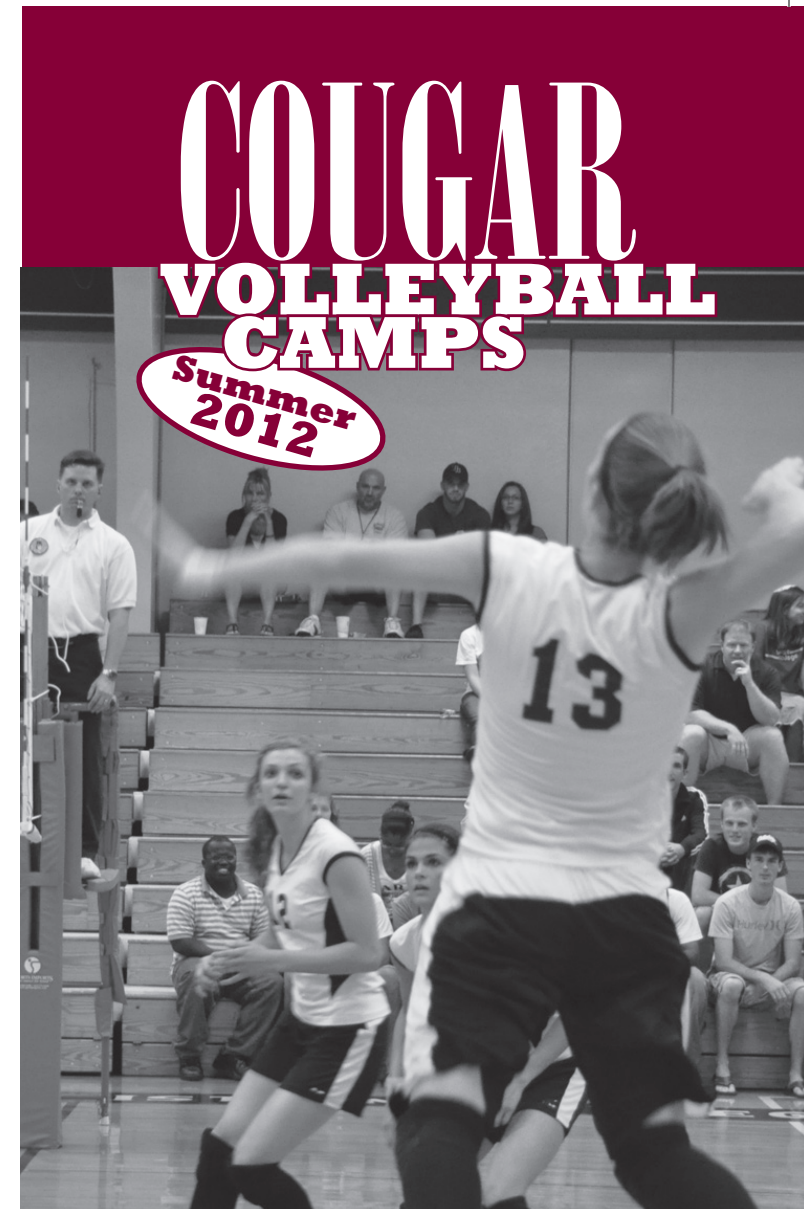

Morning instruction will be followed by afternoon team practices and evening competitions. A morning Bible Study will be held each day.

Please do not bring TV, MP3 players, headphones, excessive amounts of cash, tank tops, spandex, or "short" shorts.

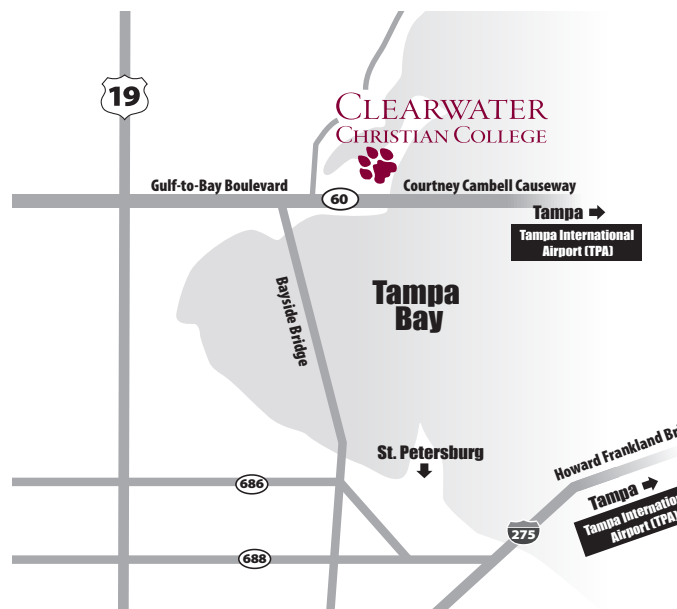

CAMP LOCATION

From I-275 (in Tampa), take the Airport/Route 60 West exit. Bearing to the left, take Route 60 (the Courtney Campbell Causeway) to Clearwater. The College is on the right as you come to the city of Clearwater. Turn right at the Clearwater Welcome Center and onto campus.

From the south, Skyway Bridge (I-275 N) to St. Petersburg, take exit 16 (Largo/Clearwater), merging onto Roosevelt Boulevard North (686 W). Stay to the right, taking the CR 611 North ramp, merging onto 49th Street North (Bayside Bridge) to Clearwater, exiting east to Tampa. The College is about 1/4 mile on the left.

CAMP DIRECTOR

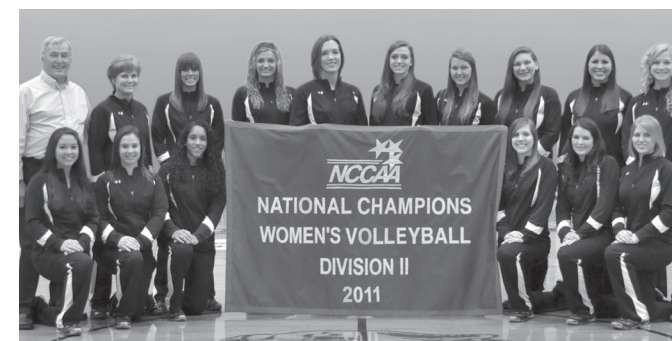
